- The Quality Assurance Analyst will also work directly with the Developers in reviewing code changes and verifying proper functionality in each testing phase ... Test, QA (Quality Assurance) and UAT (User Acceptance Testing) environments. This includes:
 - Promoting code into each successive testing environment and finally into production
 - Verifying proper code functionality in each successive testing environment
 - Working with the Developers to troubleshoot and correct issues
 - Working with the end users to test and identify corrections
- Consistently monitor PCI compliance and OWASP specifications
- Liaise with IT, Operations and Management as directed
- Perform miscellaneous job-related duties as assigned
